On February 14, 2020, a wholly owned subsidiary of Hines Global Income Trust, Inc. (the “Company”) sold Goodyear Crossing II for a contract sales price of \$72.0 million, exclusive of transaction costs and closing prorations to Industrial Logistics Properties Trust (the “Purchaser”). The Purchaser is not affiliated with the Company or its affiliates. Goodyear Crossing II is a Class-A industrial warehouse located in Goodyear, Arizona, a submarket of Phoenix, Arizona, that consists of 820,384 square feet that is 100% leased to Amazon. The Company acquired Goodyear Crossing II in August 2016 for a net purchase price of \$56.2 million.
